program in Canada. She has also taught in the United States and New Zealand. Cheryl has served as President of TTNC and continues to be actively involved. She has attended TT Dialogues for many years and currently leads a small study group. Cheryl has attended Indralaya as a student, group facilitator and mentor. She also facilitates two practice groups per month in Delta and Langley.
